As part of the UFUA continued campaign to advocate and campaign for justice for firefighters with occupational cancer, the UFUA has established the Fire Fighter Cancer Foundation and registered trademarks. To date the Australian Parliament, and the Tasmanian, South Australian and Western Australian state governments have all introduced presumptive legislation recognising the same 12 occupational cancers. This is an ongoing campaign to have all Australian firefighters, regardless of state or territory, to have the protections of presumptive legislation. The UFUA's Fire Fighter Cancer Foundation will assist with that ongoing campaign.
