VALE Senior Firefighter Peter Corner

Attention All Members:

It is with great sadness that the Union acknowledges and, with the consent of his family, formally advises of the passing of Senior Firefighter (SFF) Peter Robert Corner. The Union particularly expresses its sympathy and condolences to Peter's wife Brigitte, children, Bailey, Luca, Bella, and Ruby and to his extended family and friends.

Peter joined the WA Fire Brigade on 9th March 1984, completing his probationary training as part of Trainee Firefighter School 26 at the WAFB Training wing in Belmont. Upon completion of his training Peter served as a firefighter at Perth Station (Hay St) B Platoon commencing 30th June 1984. Peter also served at O'Connor (1987-1989) and Daglish (1990-2003) Fire Stations. SFF Corner resigned from the Fire and Rescue Service in 2003, In total serving for 19 years with the WAFB/FRS. The Union's thoughts extend to all of Peter's colleagues, serving and retired.

Prior to joining the Brigade Peter qualified as a carpenter and joiner. After his resignation from the CFRS he pursued a career in carpentry, at times working with ex firefighters Brad & Roger Pearton. As a talented athlete and sprinter, Peter represented the WAFB on numerous occasions in the McCallister Shield competing successfully against the WA Police force and the Royal Australian Navy. He was also part of the B Platoon sprint team winning the Chief Officers inter platoon sports day. In 2014 Peter and family moved to South Australia to support his family and continue his career in the building industry. Peter passed away at the age of 60 on 13th October 2022, with a funeral service and cremation being held in South Australia on the 7th of November 2022.

The Corner Family is holding a Memorial Service in WA to honour and remember Peter with family, friends, and Fire Brigade colleagues.
